Ice Breaker Questions:

1. Is there anything you do to commemorate what God has done or significant experiences with God?

Series Theme verse:

Joshua 1:10-11, Joshua 3:2-6; 9-13; 17- 4:6

Ask group members to share one thing from the sermon that stood out to them- something new to them or something they hope to put into practice. You can encourage each group member to come to each service and take notes and prepare to share one thing each week.

This helps each person put into practice James 1.22-25 NLT But don't just listen to God's word. You must do what it says. Otherwise, you are only fooling yourselves. 23 For if you listen to the word and don't obey, it is like glancing at your face in a mirror. 24 You see yourself, walk away, and forget what you look like. 25 But if you look carefully into the perfect law that sets you free, and if you do what it says and don't forget what you heard, then God will bless you for doing it.

Discussion Questions

Pastor Jeremy said that there is a new move of God coming but that we need to be READY for this and there are ways we need to prepare for it.

There are three things that we need to do:

1. We need to experience the presence of God. Exodus 33:14-16. The presence of God shows people we are different from the world. God's presence always went first. What does that mean for our life? What are some examples of how God's presence can practically be seen in our lives? Describe what it means to you to experience the presence of God?
2. The Posture we need to be in is Obedience. Joshua 3:3; 3:8; Joshua 4:10 From this passage what are the instructions we have from God that He is calling us to obey?
Obedience is when God speaks, not when we think the time is right or when it is convenient for us. Have you ever been tested in obeying even when it did not make sense to you?
3. Build a pile of Rocks. Pastor Jeremy said "a pile of rocks always points to something beyond us" . What circumstances in your life are actually a pile of rocks to point to God's glory and faithfulness? Who are you pointing to God through your piles of rocks?
